We want to express our gratitude to each of you who supports Caritas Japan's regular activities and deliver to you our annual report for fiscal 2021.

It has been two years since the world has been shaken by an invisible virus. No one knows for sure whether or when it will end. When we face such an uncertain crisis of life, we feel we are lost and wandering in darkness.

In a society dominated by uncertainty, increased anxiety, and hopelessness, we inevitably give priority to our own safety and security, becoming selfish and creating an intolerant society.

At the same time as many people face a crisis of life due to an infectious disease, many also face a crisis of life as restrictions caused by the pandemic cause economic problems and widening disparities.

Over the past two years Caritas Internationalis in cooperation with various Vatican offices has implemented support measures in response to the situation around the world through local Caritas organizations. Caritas Japan has also stepped up its support for those in need.

On December 13, 2021, Caritas Internationalis launched a new global campaign called *Together We: Act Today for A Better Tomorrow* calling for global solidarity with a view to the post-Corona world.

Pope Francis has said, "Because all creatures are connected, each must be cherished with love and respect, for all of us as living creatures are dependent on one another." He emphasizes the perspective of a comprehensive ecology, calling for global solidarity to protect our common home, the earth. In the face of increasing division and isolation, global solidarity among people that helps and supports one another is essential to protect life.




