## From Our President

Through your prayers, donations, awareness-raising, and volunteer activities you join Caritas Japan in the Church's work of love. I thank you for the part you played for Caritas Japan's activities during 2023.

Caritas Japan conducts its activities in cooperation with more than 160 Caritas organizations around the world. Each Caritas carries out activities in its own local communities and supports activities in other countries.

One effort that Caritas Japan values is support for Caritas organizations that have just been established. In a country with serious social problems such as poverty and human rights violations, a local Caritas can carry out activities in a sustainable manner that is rooted in the local community. So, it is important for a newly established Caritas to develop an organizational foundation and grow as it carries out small but valuable activities. Caritas Japan began to support newly established Caritas Laos last year and will continue to support both the organization and its activities.

In relation to the war in Ukraine, a wide range of aid activities continue in Ukraine and neighboring countries, including supplying daily necessities, taking measures against the winter cold, and providing psycho-social care.

Caritas Jerusalem provides comprehensive assistance in Gaza, including food, water, sanitation, supplies for the winter, and medical care.

The Caritas response to natural disasters includes ongoing emergency assistance for the damage caused by an earthquake in southeastern Turkey, near the border with Syria. Though it occurred one day outside of 2023, we want to inform you that Caritas Japan continues to provide support following the Noto Peninsula earthquake that occurred on January 1, 2024. Caritas Japan provides full support for the activities of the Caritas Noto Support Center established by the Diocese of Nagoya.

We hope that through Caritas Japan you will continue to walk with people in difficulty.

A Campaign briefing was held at the National General Assembly of the Major Superiors of Men and Women (May 30-June 2).

#### June

• Campaign overview and introduction at General Assembly of the Japan Federation of Catholic Women's Organizations (Nikkaren) at Beppu Church of the Oita Diocese.

• The 27th issue of the newsletter We are Caritas (WAC) is published as "Campaign Special Issue No. 2." The second year of the campaign was structured to consider "the current situation of the home and planet we live in, and the cries and voices of people," "the introduction of initiatives in schools, overseas, and Japan in response," "the world we aim for through these efforts," and added message boards, exchange cards, and postcards as a starting point for sharing and activities using the newsletter.

#### October

Coordinated by the person in charge of each diocesan Caritas (Diocesan Collaborator), by October 2024 all dioceses will organize (1) Campaign photo exhibition, (2) sharing among parishes and activity groups using WAC No. 27, and (3) Campaign candlelight Mass to present the Campaign.

#### November

Gathering of Caritas Saitama Liaison Staff. CJ Executive Director 's Lecture "Purpose and Aims of Caritas, Caritas Internationalis and CJ's Activities" and introduction to Campaign initiatives. Nagoya Diocesan Caritas Welfare Committee Memorial Mass for Precious Family and Friends. A Campaign prayer was offered and a photo exhibition was held at the same time.

#### December

In WAC No. 28 (issued at the end of November), an Advent calendar "TOGETHER WE Prayer Wreath 2023" featured the words of the encyclical *Fratelli tutti* and images and stories of people practicing the encyclical. The content was shared on Facebook each day from December 1 to 24.
